

Parcel Shipment Routing Instructions

Please ensure these requirements are followed when preparing parcel shipments. Any exceptions to these requirements must be reviewed with your Solventum representative prior to shipping.

- **DO NOT** select the declared value option for any parcel shipment.
- When shipping international shipments, you must provide the parcel account number in the duty and tax field when creating the airway bill. See page 2-6 for more information.

****To Solventum Suppliers and Solventum Shipping Facilities****

This notice is intended for facilities responsible for shipping parcels (small packages) to the United States via UPS or FedEx. Please route this to your shipping team.

As of August 29, 2025, the U.S. government has eliminated the de minimis threshold for all countries of origin. Consequently, every shipment, regardless of value, will now require formal or informal customs entry and will be subject to import duties, taxes, and fees. This regulatory change will impact the processing of low-value shipments. Previously, it was unnecessary to provide a parcel account number for duties and taxes when importing low-value shipments. However, moving forward, **a parcel carrier account number must be entered for every shipment by the shipper while creating the shipment.** Failure to provide this information will result in shipment delays or holds until the necessary funds are resolved.

Additionally, it is crucial to ensure complete and accurate export and import documentation for customs clearance. A commercial invoice must accompany each shipment and include the following details: seller and buyer information, description of goods, quantity and unit of measure, value and currency (if goods are shipped free of charge, a fair market value must be provided), country of origin, HTS code, shipment details, and terms of sale (incoterms).

The preferred Parcel Carrier to be executed on shipments to Solventum U.S. varies by Origin and is to be found in the Solventum Partners & Suppliers page: [Partners and suppliers information | Solventum](#)

Failure to comply may result in delayed or returned shipments. In such instances, the shipper will be responsible for any additional costs incurred, which may include handling, storage, or other related fees.



The shipper MUST confirm the purchasing agreement to determine which party is responsible for paying duties and taxes when shipping to the U.S. If duties and taxes are to be paid at the destination in the U.S. you must enter the recipient's parcel account number in the "bill duties and taxes" field. If the shipper is paying the duties and taxes, then the shipper's parcel account number should be entered in the "bill duties and taxes" field. More details below:

****Shipping via FedEx****

When creating the airway bill (AWB), review the Billing Details section.

When Solventum U.S. recipient is responsible for the freight and the import duty into the U.S. The shipper will enter the Solventum FedEx account number in **BOTH** fields "Bill transportation cost and Bill duties and taxes".

If the shipper is responsible for the transportation cost and the U.S. import duty. The shipper will enter their FedEx account number in **BOTH** fields "Bill transportation cost and Bill duties and taxes".

If the shipper is responsible for the transportation cost and recipient is responsible for the U.S. import duty. The shipper will enter their FedEx account number in "Bill transportation cost" field and the Solventum FedEx account number in the "Bill transportation cost and Bill duties and taxes" field

The "Bill duties and taxes" field **cannot** be left blank. If you do not know the Solventum account number please feel free to contact your Solventum Purchasing or Logistics Representative or myself (information at the bottom of this notification).

****Shipping via UPS****

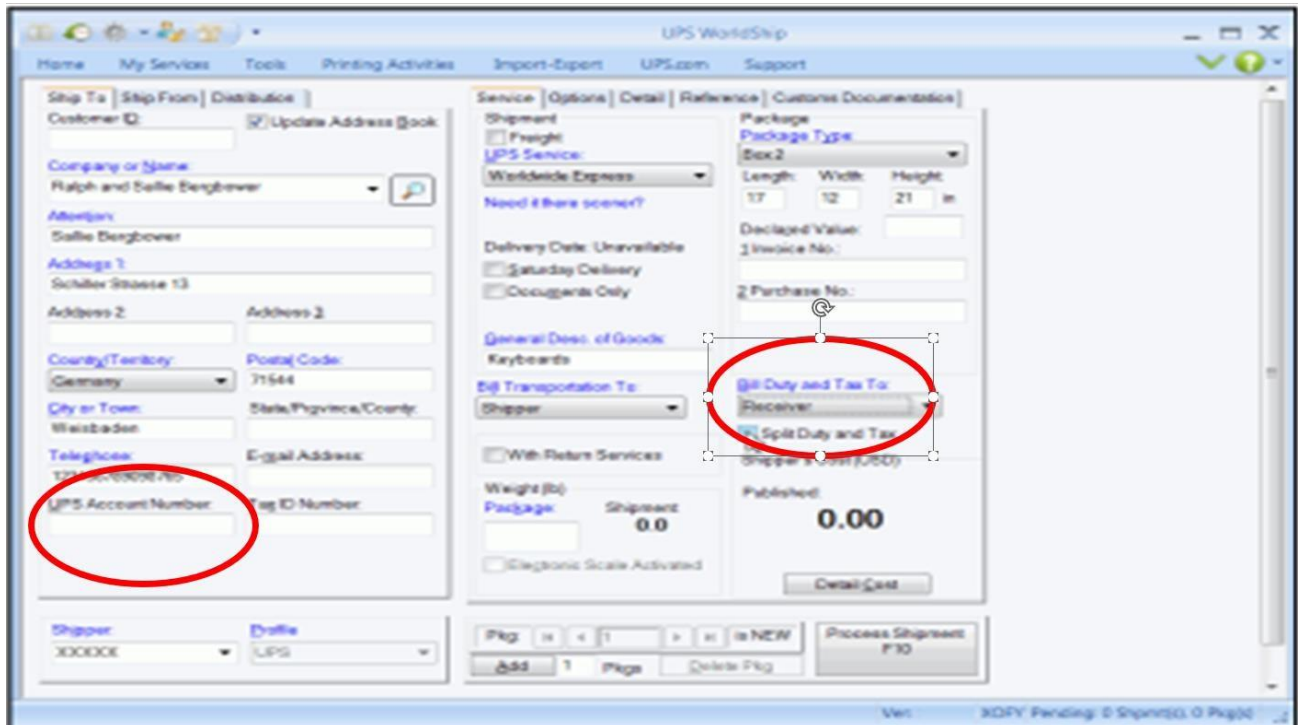
When creating the airway bill (AWB), review the Billing Details section.

When Solventum U.S. is responsible to pay the freight and the import duty into the U.S. Please enter the Solventum UPS account number in **both** Bill Transportation and Bill Duties and Taxes fields.

When the shipper is responsible for the freight and the import duty into the U.S. They will enter their UPS account number in **both** Bill Transportation and Bill Duties and Taxes fields.

If the shipper is responsible for the transportation cost and recipient is responsible for the U.S. import duty. The shipper will enter their UPS account number in “Bill transportation cost” field and the Solventum UPS account number in the “Bill transportation cost and Bill duties and taxes” field

The “Bill duties and taxes” field **cannot** be left blank. If you do not know the Solventum account number please feel free to contact your Solventum Purchasing or Logistics Representative or myself (information at the bottom of this notification





****Summary****

- Shippers must review the purchase agreement to determine which party is responsible for duty payment into the U.S.

- If the U.S. is responsible for duty payment, include the parcel account in duty payment instructions during shipment creation.

- If the U.S. is not responsible for duty payment, include the shipper's parcel account in duty payment instructions during shipment creation.
