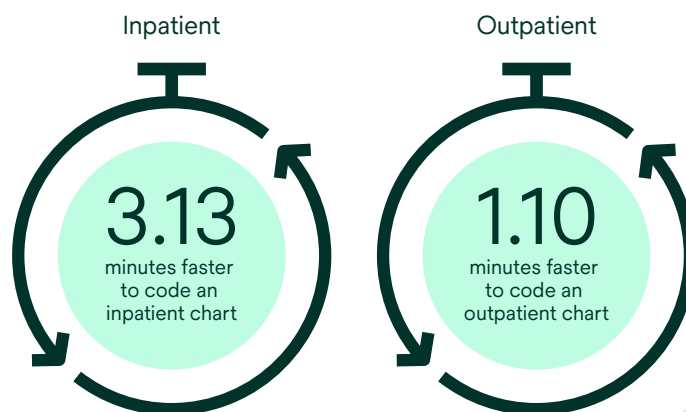
In a survey, 35% of medical groups in the U.S. report that medical coder is the most difficult revenue cycle role to hire.

Mitigate revenue pressure through denials prevention

Clinical denials continue to impact cash flow, requiring significant resources for rework and appeals — often with only partial success.

9%

of charges or 3.3% of net patient revenue are at risk due to denials although nearly two-thirds of denied claims are typically recoverable, the appeals process is costly and inefficient.

Nearly two-thirds of these being recoverable through appeals, yet only a small fraction is actually recaptured due to process inefficiencies.

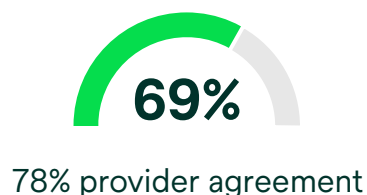

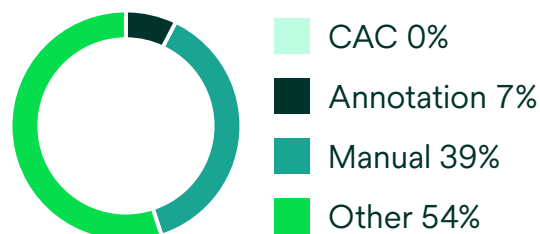

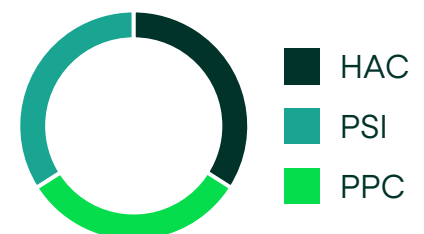
